SUBJECT: Casino Update, Town Dance, & Tree Trimming

The following provides information on the status of the proposed casino, a town dance scheduled for 6/9/18, and on-going right of way issues.

- **The Casino Project.** An article published on Friday, 6/1/18 by the Fargo Forum (see link) provides a timely and concise update on the status of proposed casino. Essentially the project appears stalled with no physical or administrative activity occurring since late last summer when Otter Tail County notified the developer that an Environmental Impact Study (EIS) is now required. The White Earth Nation will now need to determine what their next step may be.
