The public is invited to attend a Town Dance to be held at the Star Lake Township Town Hall on Saturday, June 9th, 2018. The Town Hall is located at 31030 380th Street, just west of the intersection with County Highway 41.

A local group, “The Red Herring Stringband” sponsored by the Otter Tail County Historical Society with funding from the Lake Region Arts Council will be performing the first Saturday of the month during June, July, and August as part of this year’s Otter Tail County Sesquicentennial Celebration. The event debuts in Star Lake Township on June 9th, with gatherings in New York Mills and Dalton later in the summer.

The Red Herring Band’s repertoire of heritage dance music includes fiddle tunes collected right here in Otter Tail County. These community dances were an integral part of rural culture in times of yore. Dances would be held at town halls, and dance halls like our very own Spruce Lodge, or Perry’s, and Lenny’s Dance Barn.

A request to host this venue came to The Star Lake Town Board last winter. It ties in nicely with an initiative promoted by the MN Association of Townships to encourage & nurture activities that support/build a sense of community within rural townships.

Everyone is welcome, young and old. All dances will be taught. No partner necessary. Free admission. Come, see, listen, & dance the night away!
