SUBJECT: WHERE'S THE FIRE???

You know things are not going your way when the Sheriff Deputy standing at your drivers-side window is asking you "Where's the fire???"

Yep, this bulletin is about speeding. Your Town Board would like to share a few thoughts with you on this subject.

1. The township has no legal enforcement authority for traffic laws – we don't write speeding tickets. It's up to drivers to only drive as fast as conditions safely permit, and that is often well under the posted speed limit.
2. If you observe unsafe operation of a vehicle or a watercraft for that matter, CALL THE SHERIFF. **218-998-8555**
3. You're at the lake folks, you're no longer on I-94, SLOW DOWN before someone gets hurt or worse. During this season many of our roads are congested, lake cabins are full, cars are parked on the side of the road, campers or ice castles are wedged in back lots, septic pumpers & construction vehicles are hustling about, visiting children unfamiliar with the area are playing in and around all this stuff; it's a recipe for tragic accident – don't be that person – SLOW DOWN and drive carefully.
4. Enough said – SLOW DOWN – and be sure the only fire you're at today is the one you're cooking smores over.
