## RETAIL SALE OF CANNABIS AND LOWER-POTENCY HEMP EDIBLE REGISTRATION AUTHORITY DELEGATION TO OTTER TAIL COUNTY STAR LAKE TOWNSHIP RESOLUTION NO. 2025-01

WHEREAS, the State of Minnesota passed legislation codified under Minnesota Chapter 342 legalizing the sale of lower-potency hemp edibles and cannabis products; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Cannabis Management (OCM) is the state regulatory office created to oversee the implementation and regulation of the adult-use cannabis market, the medical cannabis market, and consumer hemp industry; and

WHEREAS, the OCM governs the application and licensing process for cannabis hemp businesses; and

WHEREAS, after an applicant has been approved for licensing by the OCM, the business is required to receive a local government's retail registration; and

WHEREAS, Star Lake Township is not adopting an ordinance to regulate the retail sale of cannabis and lower-potency edibles at this time; and

WHEREAS, Star Lake Township is delegating its registration authority for the retail sale of cannabis and lower-potency edibles to Otter Tail County.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, Star Lake Township is delegating its registration authority for the retail sale of cannabis and lower-potency hemp edibles to Otter Tail County.

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing resolution was introduced by <u>Nour Hunson</u> and, after discussion thereof and upon vote being taken thereon, passed unanimously.
