

**RETAIL SALE OF CANNABIS AND LOWER-POTENCY HEMP EDIBLE
REGISTRATION AUTHORITY DELEGATION TO OTTER TAIL COUNTY
STAR LAKE TOWNSHIP RESOLUTION NO. 2025-01**

WHEREAS, the State of Minnesota passed legislation codified under Minnesota Chapter 342 legalizing the sale of lower-potency hemp edibles and cannabis products; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Cannabis Management (OCM) is the state regulatory office created to oversee the implementation and regulation of the adult-use cannabis market, the medical cannabis market, and consumer hemp industry; and

WHEREAS, the OCM governs the application and licensing process for cannabis hemp businesses; and

WHEREAS, after an applicant has been approved for licensing by the OCM, the business is required to receive a local government's retail registration; and

WHEREAS, Star Lake Township is not adopting an ordinance to regulate the retail sale of cannabis and lower-potency edibles at this time; and

WHEREAS, Star Lake Township is delegating its registration authority for the retail sale of cannabis and lower-potency edibles to Otter Tail County.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, Star Lake Township is delegating its registration authority for the retail sale of cannabis and lower-potency hemp edibles to Otter Tail County.

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing resolution was introduced by Dale Lewis, duly seconded by Dan Hanson and, after discussion thereof and upon vote being taken thereon, passed unanimously.
